WHERE ARE WE

SAMBURU NATIONAL RESERVE



Set on the banks of the Ewaso Ng'iro River and neighbouring the Buffalo Springs National Park, Samburu National Reserve is characterised by a spectacular landscape of rugged hills, undulating plains and riverine forests. The park is home to abundant wildlife

including a variety of rare species such as the Reticulated Giraffe, the long-necked Gerenuk, Somali Ostrich, Grevy's Zebra, and Beisa Oryx. Visitors can also enjoy spotting over 900 elephants, a variety of predators, and over 450 bird species. The ancient traditions of the Samburu people remain vibrant here, offering a rare glimpse into two remarkable customs. First, witness how each herdsman's unique call guides his cattle with precision. Then, experience the powerful dances performed by tribesmen—rituals that have been passed down for centuries.

MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE



The Maasai Mara together with Tanzania's Serengeti form Africa's most famous wildlife park, the Maasai Mara National Reserve. For many, the sight of Acacia trees scattered across vast grass plains captures the essence of Africa. The undeniable highlight of the

Maasai Mara National Reserve is undoubtedly the annual wildebeest migration traversing the vast plains of the Serengeti and the Maasai Mara. It is known as the largest mass movement of land mammals on the planet – with more than a million animals following the rains. Large prides of Lions, herds of Elephants, as well as Giraffes, Gazelles and Eland can also be spotted in the reserve. Aside traditional vehicle safaris, hot-air ballooning over the Mara plains has become almost essential.

LUMO WILDLIFE CONSERVANCY



Located in the Taita-Taveta County in Kenya, the Lumo Community Wildlife Sanctuary stretches over 600 square kilometres, adjacent to the Taita Hills Wildlife Sanctuary and the Tsavo West National Park. This community-run sanctuary provides ecotourism

services to protect the wildlife of the Tsavo Region, and is known for its big cat and Elephant populations. Visitors will also be able to spot Cape Buffalo, Lion, Giraffe, Zebra, Hartebeest, Leopard, Impala, Thomson's Gazelle, Lesser Kudu, Dik-Dik, and a variety of birdlife, including endemic species like the Taita Apalis and the Taita Thrush.

Set out on unforgettable game drives in open 4x4 vehicles, led by highly skilled guides with Silver and Gold level certification. With years of experience and deep knowledge of the land, they know exactly where to go and when—bringing you close to some of Africa's most iconic wildlife at just the right moments. Whether it's tracking a pride of lions at sunrise or spotting a rare bird in the treetops, your guides are passionate professionals who share both big game encounters and the quieter, often overlooked details of the bush.

STARBED EXPERIENCE



At Soroi Larsen's Camp in Samburu, a night in the starbed offers something quietly unforgettable. The bed sits beneath a glass top, open to the night sky. As you lie back, you can watch the stars move across the dark, clear sky—no filters, no barriers, just the rhythm of nature overhead. The air is cool, the silence broken only by the distant call of Hyenas and Lions or the rustle of palms in the breeze. An outdoor bathroom lets you shower under the open sky, with the scent of local plants in the air. If you choose, a private dinner can be served on the tower beside your bed:

simple, quiet, and just for two. The lantern light flickers against the wood, and the horizon fades into soft blues and greys as night settles over the bush. It's a moment to feel present, unhurried, and deeply connected to the land around you.

SUNDOWNERS



During this safari, you'll enjoy two unforgettable sundowner settings. In the Mara, our Out of Africa experience places you on the open savannah, where the sky turns shades of gold and crimson, wildlife calls echo in the distance, and drinks are served from a custom-designed sundowner vehicle.

At Lumo Conservancy, take in panoramic views from a heated infinity pool perched on a hilltop, as the sun dips below the horizon and the bush comes alive with evening sounds.

nairobi - Samburu national reserve

Your journey into the wild begins! You will take a scheduled flight from Nairobi Wilson Airport to Samburu National Reserve. On landing, you'll be transferred to the Soroi Larsens Camp, your home in the wilderness for the next three days. Settle in and prepare to explore the Samburu National Reserve.

2 SAMBURU NATIONAL RESERVE

Experience the magic of Samburu National Reserve in a day full of adventure. Your stay includes three meals daily, two shared game drives in an open 4x4 safari vehicle, and access to our photographic hide – perfect for capturing those once-in-a-lifetime wildlife moments. As the sun sets, gather around the fireplace and savour a selection of hot and cold appetisers.

3 SAMBURU - MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

Today, you'll fly from Samburu National Reserve to Maasai Mara National Reserve. You'll spend three days at Soroi Luxury Migration Camp, where you can take in the open plains, watch for wildlife, and end the day with our unique "Out of Africa" sundowner.

4 MAASAI MARA GAME RESERVE

Spend the full day exploring the Maasai Mara, one of Africa's greatest wildlife reserves. Your stay includes three meals daily, two scheduled extended game drives, and other amenities like afternoon tea/coffee with cookies/cake, campfire nibbles in the evening, and selected beverages.

5 MAASAI MARA - LUMO COMMUNITY WILDLIFE CONSERVANCY

On this day, you'll take a flight from the Maasai Mara to Taita Hills Airstrip. You'll stay at the elegant Soroi Lions Bluff Lodge, set in the heart of the Lumo Community Wildlife Conservancy. Enjoy an afternoon game drive followed by a Pool Sundowner at the lodge.

6 LUMO COMMUNITY WILDLIFE CONSERVANCY

Experience the beauty and tranquility of the Lumo Community & Wildlife Conservancy. Enjoy full-day game drives, and a reinvigorating 30-minute neck and back massage per person during your stay. A night game drive or Sunset Safari is also included for a unique perspective of the conservancy.

7 NAIROBI

On your final day, you'll take a scheduled flight from Lumo Wildlife Conservancy to Nairobi Wilson Airport, where you'll be dropped at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for your international departure.
